Casual Attire *may include:*

- Clean and presentable jeans. Denim, if worn, should be clean and in good condition, free of any tears, fading or fraying
- Collared polo shirts or casual tops; avoid Casual T-shirts that contain inappropriate logos or text that could be offensive to others
- Casual footwear, such as clean sneakers or loafers

Business Casual Attire *may include:*

- Slacks, dress pants, or khakis; or skirts or dresses of a modest, professional length
- Dress shirts, collared polo shirts, blouses, or tops
- Sweaters, cardigans
- Dress shoes, loafers, flats, or low-heeled shoes
- Business casual jeans that are clean and in good condition, free of any tears, fading, or fraying

Business Professional Attire *may include:*

- Dress shirts, ties, collared polo shirts
- Tailored sports coats or blazers worn with dress pants (not khakis)
- Tailored pantsuits
- Coordinated separates
- Closed or open toed shoes

Semi-Formal or Event *may include:*

- Dress shirts, blouses, or tops
- Tailored sports coats or blazers worn with dress pants (not khakis) Dresses and skirts
- Closed or open toed shoes
